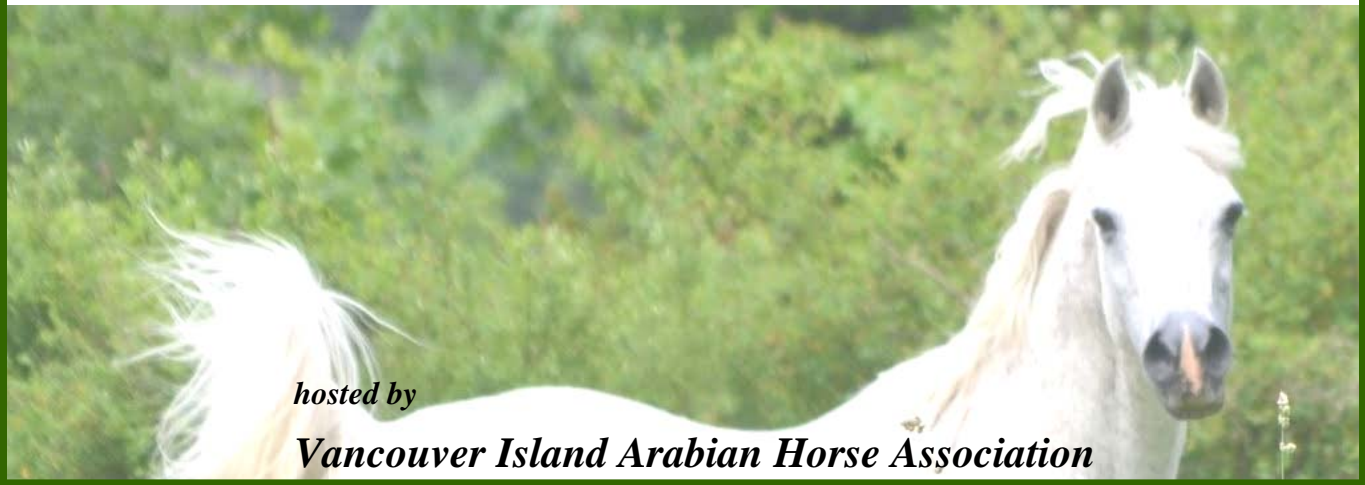

EQUESTRIAN CANADA STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLE

Equestrian Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to the humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction.

All Persons shall be committed to:

- upholding the welfare of all horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities; requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
- ensuring that all Equestrians including owners, trainers and competitors, or their respective agents, use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their own horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;
- providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure;
- providing current information on Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines and other equine health and welfare initiatives;
- continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- requiring owners, trainers and competitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions; and
- actively promoting the development and adherence of competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horse.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person who is informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and competition procedures would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

EC RULE BOOK:

“Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book.” (A602.2)

Exhibitors, Judges and Show Officials are responsible for a knowledge of the rules. The current EC Rules, full details of Horse Show Operation, and other vital information is contained in the Rule Book, which can be downloaded at www.equestrian.ca (select Rules from the left side menu). Every Senior and Junior Competitor Member is eligible to count points won at EC Recognized Shows for Annual Provincial Championship Awards.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS: Exhibitors MUST have an Equestrian Canada Bronze Sport License. Prior to the show, purchase a full EC Competitive Sport License on-line at www.equestrian.ca, or call toll free 1-866-282-8395 for a fee of \$25 + \$10 for the Adult Amateur Card. Completing the Amateur Affidavit allows the adult exhibitor to compete in any Amateur class. Juniors 10 years and under are not required to have a Sport License. A Bronze License may be purchased at the show for \$30 + \$10 for the Amateur Card.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR.

WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP.

SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

SHOW RULES

No smoking is permitted in the barns or areas with hog-fuel or shavings under foot.

Entry Forms:

The Show Committee reserves the rights to refuse any entry, and to combine or split classes if entries warrant, and also to cancel classes if there are not at least two entries for the class. A class will be split only if it results in at least 4 entries in each subsequent class. Full refund will be made for any class cancelled by the Show Committee.

Photocopies of registration papers, AHA Competition Level Membership card, EC Bronze Sport Licence/Amateur card and HCBC membership card of the current year **MUST** be enclosed with entries. NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED UNTIL THESE CARDS ARE PRESENTED TO THE SHOW SECRETARY. Exhibitors without a competition card/sport license must purchase an AHA Single Event membership (\$35) or EC Bronze License (\$30 + \$15 for Amateur Card) at the show office.

All horses **MUST** be registered with CAHR, AHRA, AHA or CPAR.

Entry forms must be signed by the **Trainer**: the Trainer is the person on the show grounds who is accepting responsibility for the entry. Refunds of entry fees or stabling fees will not be made after the closing date of entries, except with a veterinary or doctor certificate stating that the horse/rider will be unable to show.

ADDITIONAL (TBA) CLASSES:

The Additional TBA classes with the most entries will be selected to run in the TBA time slots; otherwise, first come, first served! TBA Class can be any class on the AHA Class List or that is recognized by AHA with the exception of Jumping, Working Hunter, Hunter Hack, Cutting, Reining Horse, Working Cow Horse or any Carriage Driving Class.

Dressage Times:

Times for Dressage rides will be posted on club website www.viarabianhorse.com and on club facebook page by Thursday evening.

Classes:

All classes are to be judged under the 2017 EC Rule Book, unless otherwise stated. Rules not covered by the Arabian Division of the Rule Book will be covered under their respective EC class divisions, or by the 2017 AHA Handbook. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in the governing rules, the same shall be referred to the Steward and the Show Committee, whose decision will be final.

Gate Holds and Barn Calls are a courtesy only. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be on time for the class. Gate Holds will be permitted when requested before the class previous, and may be restricted to 2 minutes at the Show Committees' discretion.

For Hi-Point Awards, entries will receive points based on the number of horses entered in a class. For example, if there are 10 horses in a class, 1st = 10 points, 2nd = 9 points, 3rd = 8 points, etc. Points awarded to first 6 places only.

Protective Headgear:

All Dressage riders, regardless of age, must wear ASTM/SEI or BSI/BS EN approved protective headgear at all times when mounted at the show grounds during the Dressage Division.

Protective headgear may be worn without penalty by exhibitors in any section of the Arabian Division. All Junior riders must wear proper fitting, ASTM/SEI or BSI/BS EN approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while mounted on the show grounds. However, the rules for appointments in divisions such as Saddle Seat and Western supersede this rule. It is highly recommended that protective head gear be worn until just before entering the show ring.

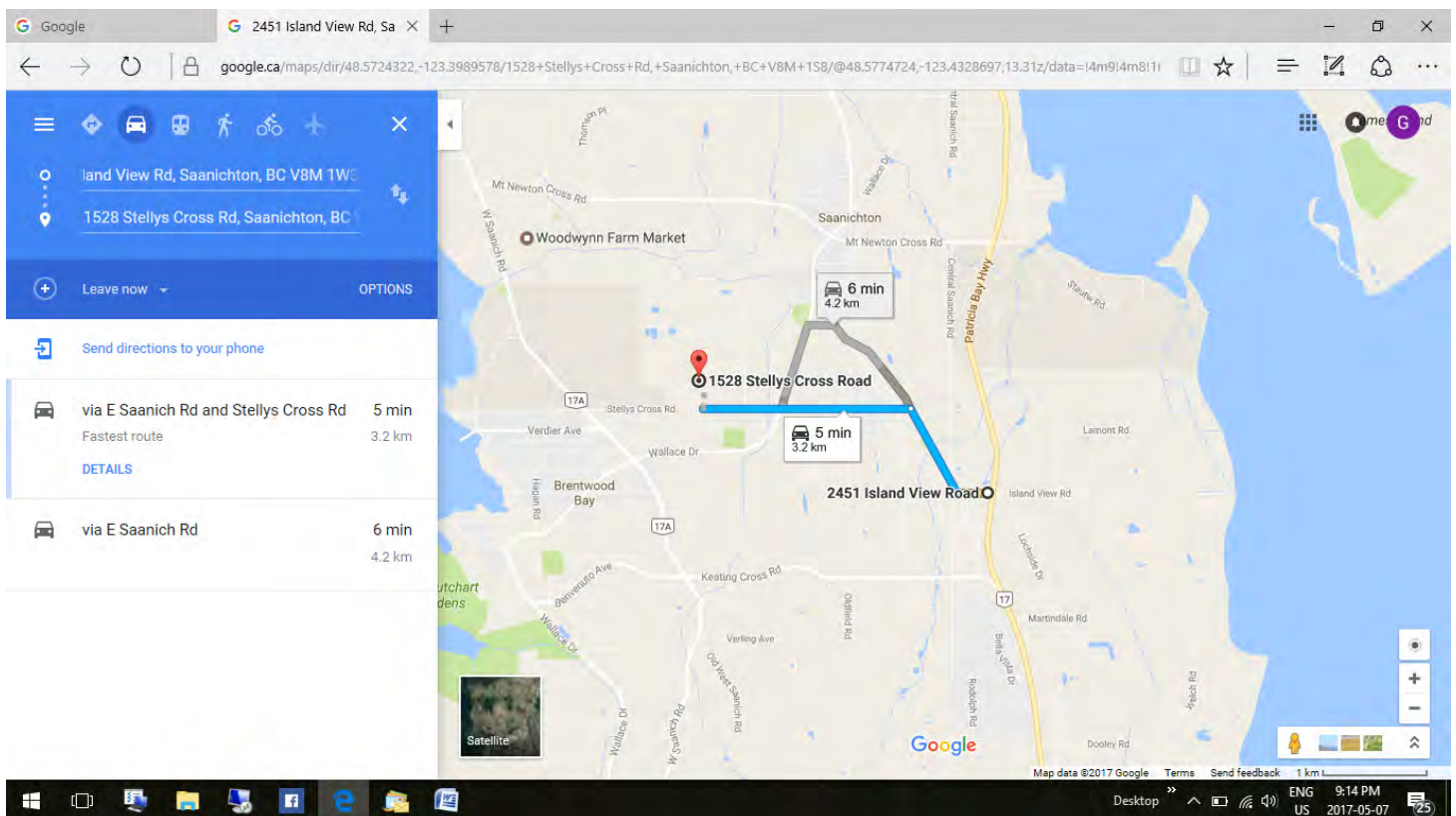
Liberty: 100% of entry fees to winner

General Rules:

1. Equestrian Canada reserves the right to have any animal at any time tested for drugs under the EC rules. EC Drug Rules will be strictly enforced. A \$3.50 Drug Fee will be charged for each horse at this event. Any horse entered in any class at a competition subject to the requirement to pay drug testing fees may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location.
2. The Show Committee reserves the right to have any animal measured for toe length or to have it's shoe weights checked. Maximum 4 1/2 inch toe length and 14 ounce shoes. Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabians may have a 5 inch foot.
3. All animals shall be subject to a Veterinary inspection, if such examination is deemed advisable. Horses shall be shown without artificial appliances, stimulants or sedatives.

- All horses artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before coming into the show arena will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that an exhibitor has made, or has caused to be made, any false statement in regard to any animal or exhibitor, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the Judge in the performance of his duties, he or she will be excused from the competition.
- No abuse of horses will be tolerated. Any animal with a visible whip mark, or evidence of blood in the mouth or on the sides will be excused from the ring. Any person reported to show management as abusing a horse, anywhere on the show grounds, or causing a disturbance as to affect the conduct and safety of other horses, and/or exhibitors, and/or spectators, shall be liable for disciplinary action. (See EC Rule Book Section B, B1306.2-5)
- A Protest must be made in writing, addressed to the Show Secretary, and accompanied by a \$100.00 deposit in cash. It must be received within 48 hours of the Alleged Violation. All protests will be handled according to the Rules of the Equestrian Canada.
- There will be no conferring with the Judge prior to or during the show. If anyone desires to meet with the Judge, this can be arranged through the Show Chairman and in the presence of the Show Steward.
- Exhibitor numbers must be worn in the paddock or warm-up area prior to the class and in the show arena during competition. Failure to wear a competition number during the class may result in disqualification by the judge.
- Refunds of entry fees or stabling fees will not be made after the closing date of entries, except with a veterinary or doctor certificate stating that the horse/rider will be unable to show
- A substitution of a horse is allowed if the original entry cannot be shown and is scratched from the show. A fee of \$25.00 will be levied for a substitution, except in the case of equitation classes where no fee will be levied.
- Hors concours is allowed but must pay required class entry fee for any class entered.
- Horses may not arrive before 6:00 pm Friday evening. All horse trailer traffic must use Gate 6 from Stelly's Cross Road.



CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Every class offered herein is covered by the Rules and Specifications of the current Rules of the Equestrian Canada and will be held and judged in accordance with the 2017 EC Rule Book.

Sport Horse In-Hand:

Horses will be shown individually on the Triangle.

See EC Rule Book Section B Chapter 24 for ring procedure and class specifications.

Arabian Halter, In-Ring Procedure:

See EC Rule Book Section B Chapter 14 for ring procedure and class specifications.

Most Classic and Most Classic Head:

Open to horses 2 years old and over. First Place only will be awarded. See Article B1405 and Article B1406.

Most Classic to be judged on type, presence, animation, carriage and conformation.

Most Classic Head to be judged against Breed Standards (Article B1301).

AHA Medal Classes:

All AHA medal equitation classes are open to juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1st, and are governed by the 2017 Equestrian Canada Equitation Division rules. Horses must be registered Arabians or Half-Arabians or Anglo-Arabians. Manageable stallions are permitted. In order for an AHA Medal to be awarded, at least three entries with proper appointments must compete. For AHA Medal classes with fewer than 3 competitors, AHA Medal points will be earned. Classes offered:

Hunter Seat Medal Class Not to Jump

Saddle Seat Medal Class

Reining Seat Medal Class

Western Horsemanship Medal Class

Dressage Seat Medal Class

Equitation class procedures and specifications are in the EC Rule Book, Section B, Chapter 36. For Dressage Seat, see also EC Rule Book, Section E, Article 8.7.

Liberty Class:

Open to Purebred and Partbred Arabians. Exhibitor to supply own music. First Place only will be awarded. Horses must enter & exit the ring wearing a suitable halter or headstall. A maximum of 3 handlers in the ring per horse using halter whips only; NO form of rattle, shaker or plastic, etc. or treats may be used inside or outside the ring.

Time at Liberty: 2 1/2 minutes. Horses should display Arabian type and presence. To be judged on presence, type, animation, carriage and conformation.

Time limit to catch horse: 1 1/2 minutes. Entries will be disqualified if not caught in allotted time, or if any aids such as carrots or grain are used.
