SHOW RULES

1. All classes will be judged according to the General Performance Rules.
2. Exhibitors must follow all rules of the Saanich Fall Fair Horse Show and the Saanich Fall Fair.
3. Entries received after the Closing Date accepted at the discretion of the show committee.
4. The Saanich Fair reserves the right to refuse entry to any party or parties.
5. Exhibitors must produce proof of Horse Council membership.
6. Proper hats and riding boots must be worn by all riders at all times while riding on the show grounds and in the warm up ring. All equipment must be in proper working order.
7. No training equipment will be allowed in the show arena.
8. At this show, all horses in all Western classes may be shown in a snaffle bit.
9. Numbers may be displayed on exhibitor's back or on the saddle pad. If displayed on the saddle pad, it must be on both sides. (Extra number provided by exhibitor).
10. No one is allowed to approach or ask questions of the judge during the show unless authorized by the show committee
11. Juniors are prohibited from handling or riding a stallion in any class unless authorized by the show committee at least 3 days prior to the show.
12. Vehicles and/or trailers are NOT allowed to enter or exit the grounds between 9:00 am & 6:00 pm - NO EXCEPTIONS!
13. No horses may arrive before Friday.
14. Vehicles in unauthorized locations will be towed.
15. Exhibitors and their Coaches/Trainers must read and agree to adhere to the VIAHA CODE OF CONDUCT.

- ❖ Exhibitor's age is as of January 1, 2018
- ❖ Classes may not run in strict numerical order.
- ❖ Classes will not begin before the times listed in this prize list. Lunch Breaks will be announced approximately 1 hour before the break.
- ❖ **Prize money** will be awarded for CHAMPIONSHIP Classes: **\$25** for 1st place, **\$15** for 2nd place, **\$10** for 3rd place
- ❖ Gate calls are a courtesy only. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be on time for their classes.
- ❖ The Walk-Trot/Jog classes on the Saturday schedule do not qualify for any Championship classes on the following days.
- ❖ The 4 Open classes on the Saturday schedule do qualify for their respective Championship classes on the following days.
- ❖ Stalls are on a first-come/first-served basis to those entered in the show. Tack stalls are only available after all horses are stabled.
- ❖ A golf cart is usually available to transport feed and tack if you are parked outside the fenced area.

Fillable Show Forms

The forms in this package can be completed on-screen. They will keep a running total for all items entered and will calculate the total amounts to send in.

The forms may be printed and completed by hand, but you will have to do all the calculations!

Notes!

1. **Navigating through the forms** – tap in the first field to fill in or position your mouse over it and click, then type in your information; to go to the second field, tap the field or use the Tab key or reposition the mouse and click. With a standard keyboard, use the Tab key to move sequentially through a form; tap or mouse click to skip a block of fields that are not needed.
2. **Calculation of Fees** -
 - Entry Form: You will have to add up the class fees for each line of classes that you are entering; the form will then add that amount to the Total Class Fees line below, and calculate the Total Entry Fees.
 - Stabling Form: Enter the number of stalls of each type that you need; the form will calculate the correct amounts owing.
 - If paying for multiple entries, you may complete only 1 stabling form. It would be appreciated if the stabling form is sent in the same envelop with all the entries for these horses.

Make one payment for the Total Entry Fees plus the Total Stabling Fees by cheque or eTransfer. Contact the Entry Secretary to pay by eTransfer.

A separate cheque is required for the Total Clean-Out Deposit, if necessary.

3. **Signatures** - The official copies of the forms must be signed! Print the forms after you have filled them in and collect all the required signatures.

After filling in the forms to your satisfaction, use the buttons below to save and/or print your entry before sending it in.

It is recommended that you give your completed form a unique name when you save it.

Print your form to collect the appropriate signatures.

Clear all the forms so you can start over with another entry.
